

Instructions

Device Installation and Removal: Open the Quick Release Plate Locking Knob $^{\textcircled{2}}$ to the left and remove the Quick Release Plate $^{\textcircled{6}}$. Align the threaded hole in the bottom of the camera or phone clip with the 1/4"–20 Screw $^{\textcircled{0}}$, turn the D-type screw on the bottom of the quick release plate by hand until it is locked, then snap the quick release plate into the base bayonet, and lock the knob $^{\textcircled{2}}$ to secure the device

Vertical Tilt: When used with a camera or fixed phone clip, if you need to turn the device to a fixed angle to shoot, release the Side Flip Locking Knob (§) counterclockwise, flip the gimbal base to an angle. and then rotate the lock knob clockwise until the

Horizontal rotation: rotate the Horizontal Rotation Locking Knob® counterclockwise can adjust the gimbal damping, and the head can be rotated horizontally 360°. Rotate clockwise to lock.

Pitch Forward and Backward: to adjust the front and rear pitch angles, rotate the Handle® counterclockwise, push the gimbal to the desired angle, and rotate the handle clockwise until the device is fixed at that angle.
